## Guest Speakers



Owen Montague

**Owen Montague** graduated from the National Ballet School, Toronto, and has been a dancer with the National Ballet of Canada, the Netherlands Dance Theatre, Aterballetto, Ballet British Columbia and Alberta Ballet. More recently, Montague has worked as an independent artist and choreographer. He was the Drake Professor at Kobe College from 2010-2011 and then taught there again from 2014-2017 in the Music Department's dance program, which was established in 2006.



Janine Shelby

**Janine Shelby** is an Associate Professor in the Department of Psychiatry at the Harbor-University of California Los Angeles Medical Center, where she also directs Child Psychology Training and the Child Trauma Clinic. Dr. Shelby has done relief work, crisis and acute intervention, consultation, and psychosocial program development following dozens of disasters in devastated communities across the globe. At Kobe College, she has studied how Western-based trauma treatments differ from clinical practices for trauma survivors in Japan.

### 2018-2019 Drake Guest Professor Position: Intercultural Studies Department

Intercultural Studies: Subject areas ranging from literature to sociology, economics, law, and philosophy, categorized into eight major subject groups. Third-year students design their own course of study by combining a secondary course with their main course.
